I. Old Business:

- a. Parental Involvement: HB 3076 and SB 283 met: Council approved drafting letter for the parenting class, preventing teenage pregnancy, abstinence, human sexuality and dating/family violence. This letter will allow parents to review curriculum and remove their student from certain instruction without penalty.
- b. Curriculum on human sexuality/alcohol awareness: Council approved:
 - AIM for Success as curriculum for 7th grade – 12th grade
 - 4th & 5th grade will continue with the Always Changing program
 - 6th grade council approved Choose Respect
 - Alcohol awareness will be provided to the 5th & 6th grade Junior High Students with approved guest speakers from UTMB and the Teen Health Clinic and in the Healthy & Wise curriculum.
 - P.A.P.A. parenting curriculum will continue at the High School & Jr. High if needed.

II. New Business:

- a. Alcohol awareness/binge drinking: included in AIM for Success-SB1344

III. School Health Program

- a. Will work with Chartwells to develop required plan for measuring implementation of our local wellness policy as required in the Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act of 2004.
- b. Continue to support and encourage lessons from Healthy and Wise/Sparks Curriculum at Primary and Crosby.
- c. Per the State districts do not have to offer Health Education to graduate, Hitchcock ISD will continue to offer health education. Health Education will continue in the Junior High Physical Education Classes.
