 - a. School health survey reviewed. Health education in middle school is not a priority and with the increased sedentary life, obesity and high risk factors involved with teenagers we will be presenting recommendation for the PE department to teach health education on Tuesdays or Thursdays (or one day a week) to all 7th and 8th graders. School year 2011-12 will pull current health education books and present to PE teachers to work into their lesson plans for K-12th. Health and Wise curriculum may also be utilized. Will hold in-services for all PE teachers next school year.
 - b. Healthy school environment: Have reviewed the bat controls in schools will present to Safety Officer and Board on adding process what to do when bats are found on campuses. Educational flyer and report forms will be sent out to campuses if approved.
