SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 is a nondiscrimination statute enacted to prohibit discrimination and to assure that eligible students with disabilities have educational opportunities and benefits equal to those provided to students who are not disabled. An eligible student under 504 is one who has a physical or mental impairment which substantially limits a life activity such as, but not limited to, eating, sleeping, standing, reading, learning, thinking, concentrating, communicating, self-care, walking, seeing, speaking, breathing, working, or performing manual tasks. If you feel that your child may have a disability that substantially affects one of these major life activities, please contact your child's school counselor or the district's Section 504 Coordinator:
