While in the program, high school students are able to take college-level coursework taught by college faculty at a fraction of the tuition cost.

Dual credit classes are taught by COM faculty on high school campuses, COM college campus (main campus and League City) or online. Upon successful completion of the course, students receive college and high school credit.

Why participate in Dual Credit?

- Earning college credit early at a reduced cost can save time and money
- Accessibility to college resources such as library access, tutoring services, career exploration and more
- Ease the transition between high school and college in a familiar, supportive environment
- Foundational courses that apply toward an academic transfer program at COM or are intended to transfer to a public college or university in Texas

Who can enroll in Dual Credit courses?

- Students enrolled in participating local high schools or are home-schooled may be eligible to participate
- Students enrolled in Dual Credit must fulfill Texas Success Initiative requirements, any additional course/program prerequisites and high school requirements
- In addition to these requirements, students must meet all requirements for standard admission to COM as outlined in the Academic Catalog
