What?

Child Find is a process to locate, identify and evaluate individuals with disabilities who may need special education and/or related services specific to their individual needs.

Why?

Early identification and intervention may help overcome barriers to learning.

Who?

Anyone may refer children, ages 0-22 years, who are experiencing learning difficulties. Learning difficulties may include: Specific Learning Disability, Auditory Impairment, Visual Impairment, Deaf-Blindness, Intellectual Disability, Emotional Disturbance, Orthopedic Impairment, Speech and/or Language Impairment, Autism, Other Health Impairment, Traumatic Brain Injury, Multiple Disabilities, Noncategorical Early Childhood.
