8:00-8:30	Teacher Prep/Small Group Time	<p>Students receive <b>240+minutes</b> of both synchronous and/or asynchronous instruction each day.</p> <p>Daily schedules are provided to parents and students.</p> <p>Students will attend live sessions for community building, counselor guidance, and intervention or enrichment. These live lessons will allow peer-to-peer interaction and relationship connections with teachers. Campus counselor will post weekly guidance lesson as well as setting up one-on-one or small group guidance classes to support social and emotional learning. Please reach out to counselors with concerns.</p> <p>Content for core subject areas will be provided through the TEKS Resource System and supplemented by our campus instructional resources.</p> <p>In grades 6-8, content and instruction is provided by departmentalized teachers. These teachers are the point of contact for their prospective subject areas. Office hours will be available for one-on-one conferences during the day and before and after school for parent and student assistance.</p> <p>Attendance will be taken daily in TxEIS, as determined through engagement. Grading will be the same as on-campus learning and outlined in our HISD District Handbook and policy. The Learning Management System (LMS) for grades 6- 8 is Google Classroom.</p> <p>Each class will include a 3E Model: engagement, elaboration, and evaluation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Engagement- bell ringer, video, etc.</li> <li>2. Elaboration- I Do, We Do, You Do</li> <li>3. Evaluate- exit ticket, short answer response, written assignment or completion of task, etc.</li> </ol>
